Boyd/Myers Bull Customer:

Thank you for being a customer of our bull sales over the past years, it is our sincere hope that the bulls you have purchased have helped you move your herd in a positive direction. We continue to work hard to provide you with the kind of genetics that will help you fit your cattle into the ever-increasing demands of the marketplace.

As a service to our bull customers, we invite you to take advantage of our feeder calf marketing program. Our goal is to provide an opportunity for you to reap the benefits of purchasing superior genetics and providing sound management. This fall our sale will be held at Blue Grass Stockyards in Lexington on November 28.

We will comingle the calves that are weaned 45 days+ and had two rounds of vaccine then sell any unweaned or short weaned calves afterwards by consignor. The deadline to wean calves for the comingled sale will be October 18.

Cattle will need to arrive on Sunday November 27 between 9AM and 2PM, they will be weighed, graded, and comingled into sale lots then put on feed and water for the night for sale on Monday morning, the short weaned or bawling calves will sell one consignor at a time with the calves weighed at the time of the sale on Monday. The cattle will sell at approximately 10:30 AM and Blue Grass will sell all the cattle in our program then resume the regular sale.

The basic health program that we recommend for the calves is:

Weaned at least 45 days
2 rounds of viral vaccines, 1 of which is modified live
2 rounds of Clostridials(Blackleg)
Pasteurella
dewormed, dehorned, knife castrated and healed.

Ear tags for the program are provided by Blue Grass Stockyards at no cost to you and will be shipped from them directly to you. When your tags are shipped there will be a health form included that you will need to fill out and bring with your cattle when you deliver. The sale cost will be a flat rate of \$25/head which includes the free ear tag and any hay needed to hold the calves over Sunday night.

We encourage our bull customers to consider the option of enrolling in AngusLink, if not this year in the future. This program offers the opportunity for an added layer of value. If you have questions about the
